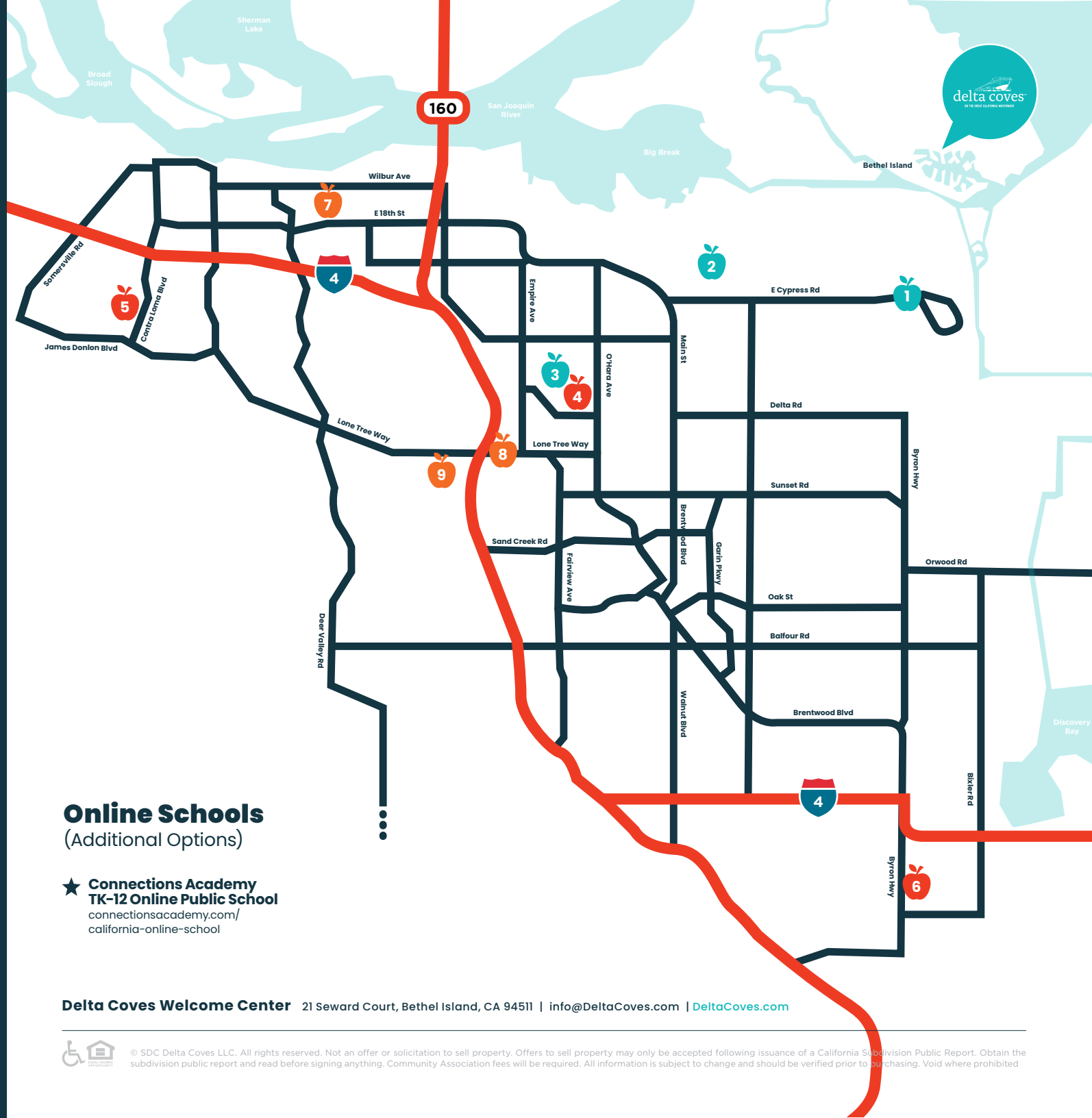

Oakley Union Elementary School District and Liberty Union High School District are the public-school districts that serves Delta Coves. Each school in the district offers programs in conventional education, special education and early childhood. There are also career, STEM, technical and alternative high school services available.

Within close proximity to Delta Coves, there are additional schools that offer a range of services and programs to fit the needs of all resident families, including alternate public, charter and private schools.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What school district is Delta Coves in?

Delta Coves is located within the Oakley Union Elementary School District and the Liberty Union High School District.

What school will my children attend?

Elementary students will enroll at Summer Lake Elementary and middle school aged students will enroll at Delta Vista Middle School. All high school students will attend Freedom High School. Individual schools are subject to changes in attendance boundaries. Please contact each respective school district for the latest information.

What's the difference between a public school, a charter school and a private school?

Every school has its own personality, focus, traditions and reputation in the community. School choice is based on academic offerings, athletics, mission and vision of the school. Public schools are universal, and available to everyone. Public schools and high schools are funded and controlled by The United States Department of Education on the federal level, state-level departments of education and by the school district at the local level. Each school district sets the curricula, funding and employment for schools within their boundaries, with direction from the state.

Charter schools are independently managed, tuition-free schools, that are state-funded in a manner that is distinct from how traditional schools are funded. Charter schools operate under a "charter" or a contract between the school and the state or jurisdiction, allowing for autonomy and flexibility. Charter schools have grown into a significant alternative system within California's K-12 public

schools, with more than 1,200 schools serving more than 600,000 students.

Private schools are not funded or operated by federal, state or local governments. They are not paid for by public tax dollars and are not subject to the regulations that govern public schools. At private schools, students pay tuition to attend.

Are students able to attend schools outside their assigned school?

Although students have the right under California law to free, public education, the law does not guarantee that a student can attend the school of his or her choice. Enrollment is based on available classroom space. Enrollment applications are approved on a year-by-year basis with no guarantee of continued enrollment. While most campuses will have space for student enrollment, some campuses will have closed enrollment because of growing student populations. Intra-District transfers are transfers between two schools within the boundaries of the District. To begin this process, you will complete the Intra-District Transfer request form and email to the school your child should be attending based on your address. Once your school of residence signs off on the transfer request, they will forward the form to the school that you would like your child to attend. These decisions are made by the site principals and their decisions are final.

How can I access more information?

It is always best to contact the school district or the individual school directly for information concerning enrollment, district boundaries, or the status of individual schools.
